## Sustainability and Resiliency Working Groups

- Two new working groups at the Iowa DOT
- November 30<sup>th</sup> Visioning Workshop
- Current Definitions
  - Sustainability: The System is available and in a good condition, meeting the needs of today and the future. When transportation is sustainable, the economic environmental, and societal factors are in harmony – one is not being sacrificed for another.
  - Resiliency: The ability to anticipate, prepare for, and adapt to changing conditions and withstand, respond to, and quickly recover from disruptions.

## Upcoming Items

- Work program guidelines will be reviewed for changes and will be sent out in January.
- Planning funding targets for agency work programs will be drafted/finalized early February.
- Census
  - Fall/Winter 2021: The Census Bureau will publish a Federal Register notice with the final criteria defining urban areas based on the results of the 2020 Decennial Census.
  - Spring/Summer 2022: The Census Bureau will publish a Federal Register notice announcing the qualifying urban areas based on the results of the 2020 Decennial Census and release TIGER/Line geographic shapefiles on their website.
    - HEPGIS will provide urban area boundaries, including the ability to download shapefiles.
- IIA information will be reviewed and communicated to agencies as it becomes available.
